#### Certification ACF GGR Chapter

- Certification event must have a minimum of 3 participants to qualify for GGR Chapter to cover expenses
- Chapter will cover cost of hosting the exam
  - Covers
    - Mileage of Proctors and Test Administrator
    - Hotel / Meal Accommodations as needed (with Board Approval)
    - Food and Beverage for Proctors and Event Personnel -
    - Members is good standings will have their Site Fee returned upon successful certification passing

Chapter Officers and Chairs - Site Fee Waved/Paid for by Chapter

\*Up to 2 attempts, if unsuccessful

\*Good for all certifications other than CMC

\*Any specialty certification event held for 2 or less candidates shall be underwritten fully by the candidate's employer. This includes the same expectations as the section above under the section: "Chapter will cover cost of hosting the exam."

Questions:

- What kind of chapter support (money & resources) available for CMC exam?
  - Chapter member must apply to Board in writing for approval to take the CMC exam seeking GGR ACF Chapter sponsorship.
    - The letter should address the length of membership, offices/ chairs held, fundraising involvement, lifetime involvement with ACF, who the CMC Certification will personally benefit as well as the Chapters benefit.
  - CMC Candidate shall be awarded ½ Cost up front (estimated at \$2,500) for the attempt.
  - o CMC Candidate will be awarded FULL COST Sponsorship upon Passing (estimated \$5,000)
